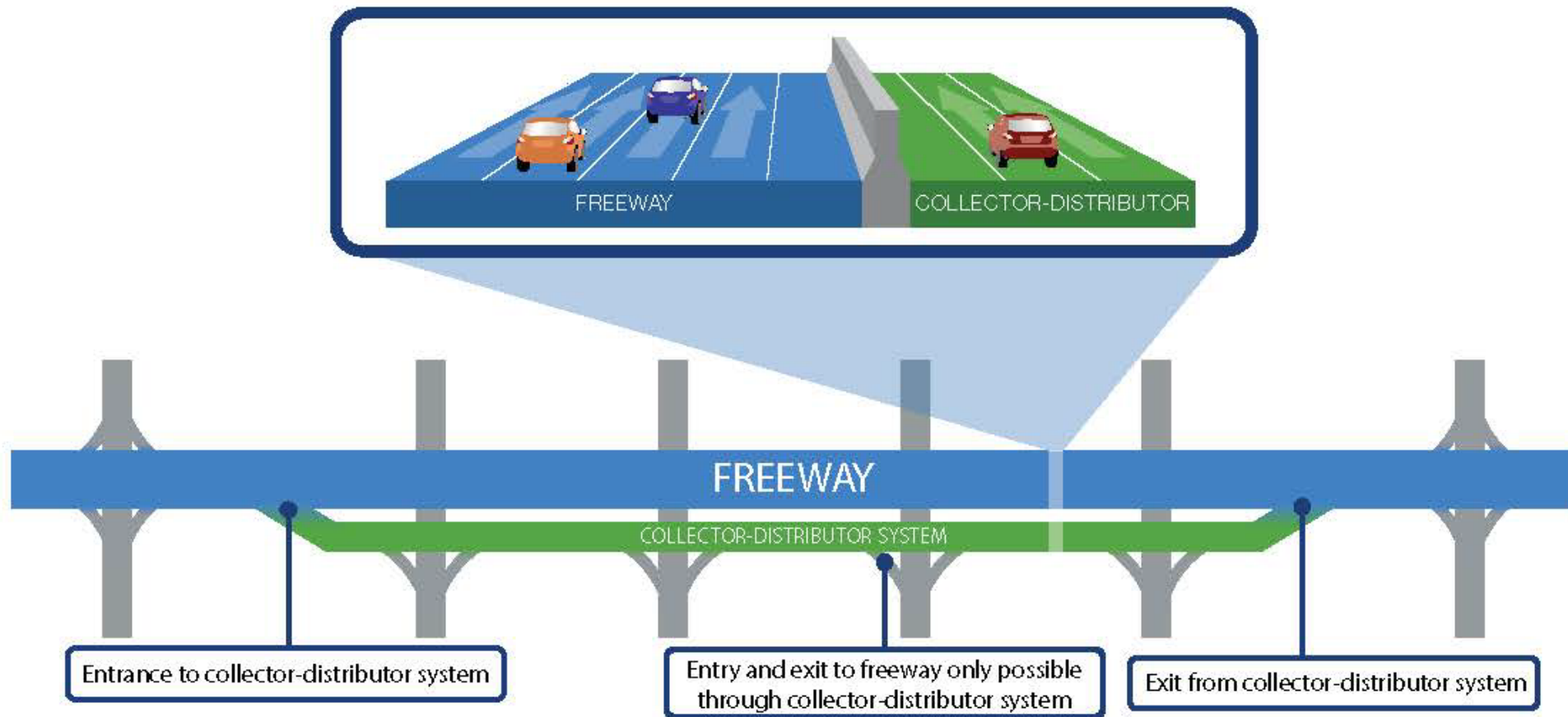

Schedule

- Environmental Assessment (EA) – January to December 2018
- Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) – Dec. 6, 2018
- Public meetings and comment periods
 - Scoping – Jan. 30, 2018
 - Alternatives – May 2, 2018
 - Public Hearing – Aug. 21, 2018

Environmental Assessment (EA)

- EA is available on the project website: udot.utah.gov/i15northbound
- Evaluated numerous environmental resources including:
 - Historic architecture
 - Right-of-way/relocations
 - Air quality
 - Noise

Noise Study Results

- Noise impacts to adjacent residents
- 14 noise walls were evaluated
- Three noise walls met the requirements in UDOT's Noise Abatement Policy (pending balloting)
 - Bangerter Highway to 13200 South (Draper)
 - Will ballot when the next phase of the project is funded
 - **Copperview Recreation Center to Center Street (Midvale Noise Wall)**
 - **Center Street to approximately 7200 South (Midvale Noise Wall)**

Midvale Noise Wall

- 16 feet tall
- 10 feet tall on Wasatch St. and Center St. bridges



Noise Balloting

- Ballots have been sent to property owners and residents who are either directly adjacent to the end of the noise wall or benefited by the noise wall (defined as receiving at least a 5 dBA reduction).
- To build a wall:
 - At least 75% of ballots need to be completed and returned.
 - 75% of returned ballots need to be in favor.
 - If property owners and residents vote to reject construction of a noise wall, there will not be another opportunity to address noise impacts until there is another project that adds the same area.

Noise Balloting Schedule

- **Jan. 29** – Mailed initial ballots (352)
- **Feb. 13** – Mailed ballots via certified mail (321)
- **Feb. 21** – Public meeting on noise
- **March 1** – Ballots due
- **March 4-8** – Collect ballots door-to-door if needed
